

Alabama shorted 20,000 vaccines in next week's shipment, say feds cut allotment



Alabama's health officials learned Thursday that about 20,000 Pfizer vaccines slated for arrival for next week's shipment are not coming.

"Clearly there's not enough product to go around. There's not as much as they were anticipating, and no one has given us an adequate explanation," said Alabama Health Officer Scott Harris.
